means "cool" or "awesome"

"Sick":



"That new video game is sick, I can't stop playing it."





"Hang out":

means "to spend time with friends"



"Let's hang out this weekend, we haven't seen each other in a while."





means "before anyone else" or "boyfriend/girlfriend"

"I can't wait to see my bae tonight, we have a date planned."





means "relax" or "calm down"

"Chill"



"I had a long day at work, I just want to chill and relax at home tonight."





means "exciting" or "very good"



"That party last night was lit, I had so much fun."





means "to do something well" or "to succeed"

"She slayed her presentation, everyone was impressed."

"Low-key":

means "to keep something secret" or "not too extreme"

> "I'm trying to keep my new job low-key until I know for sure if I'm going to stay there."





"Gucci":

means "good or great"

"I just got a new Gucci bag, it's so sleek and stylish."

In this sentence, "Gucci" is being used as slang to mean "good" or "great." The speaker is expressing excitement over their new purchase and is praising its design and quality.





"Shook"

means "surprised" or "shocked"



"I was shook when I found out that I won the lottery"
